It is with great sadness that we announce the tragic loss of Christopher John Page, age 53, on May 10, 2026 in San Diego, California. Chris was born in Franklin, Tennessee on June 26, 1972 and his family later settled in Roswell, Georgia, where he enjoyed a wonderful childhood. He graduated from Roswell High School, where he was a star athlete in both football and basketball. He earned several awards including the Atlanta Touchdown Club Lineman of the Year and induction into the RHS Hall of Fame. Chris attended the University of Kentucky on a football scholarship, became a three-year letterman, and graduated in 1997. After college, Chris began a successful career in executive recruiting. He quickly became a respected leader in his field, known for his natural ability to build strong, lasting relationships and for his dedication to helping others succeed. Chris always loved the ocean and the outdoors. He lived in Folly Beach, South Carolina before moving to San Diego—where he called home for the rest of his life. He

traveled

often to find great surfing in Mexico, Hawaii, and Costa Rica. He was also a musician—writing songs and playing the guitar as well as going to live shows.

He

adored his three rescued bulldogs—Lou, Buddy & Maggie—and gave them a loving

home. Chris had a great sense of humor and joyful spirit—everyone loved being in his

company.

Chris had countless friends, hobbies and interests, but his greatest love was his two

boys, Robbie and Jack. Spending time with them—whether it was coaching sports,

surfing, or watching the Padres— brought him immense joy.

Chris is survived by his sons, Robbie (19) and Jack (16), and their mother, Dana. He is

also survived by his mother, Linda, and siblings Neil (Meg), Tricia (Nathan) and Libby

(Tim) and several nephews and nieces. We all loved him dearly and are devastated by

his loss. Chris is preceded in death by his father, Bob.

A funeral mass will be held on May 29 th at 11am at Saint Brigid Catholic Church in San

Diego. Following the service, the family invites friends and loved ones to a reception to

celebrate Chris's life.
