It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of Isaac Paul Whiting, who left us peacefully on December 08, 2024, at the age of 43. Isaac was a beloved Son, Brother, Uncle, and Friend. He was known for his kindness, generosity, unique outlook on life, and sense of humor.

Isaac was born on January 27, 1981 in Ocean Beach, a community in San Diego, California. In 1981, being born with Spina Bifida (the most prominent of his many medical obstacles) did not bode well for a life at all, let alone one of quality. But Isaac beat all the odds.

He lived independently from the age of 21, doing things for himself but drawing on the help of others when needed, most especially his long-time caregiver and friend Josh. He was a lifelong learner, attending Cuyamaca and Grossmont Community Colleges, studying literature, music, theater, and (most recently) criminal justice.

Isaac attended many camps where he made lifelong friends, starting with the JAWS summer sports camp in San Diego, then the sports camp in Chico, Ca (where he made his lifelong friend Katie), and finally, the wonderful WABE camp at Whidbey Island.

But even more importantly, Isaac loved music and dance. He attended many

many live music events, including local open mics, local cover and tribute bands, and also his favorite artists like Elton John, Weird Al, Billy Joel, Paul McCartney, Cracker and Camper Van Beethoven, Morrissey, and Bob Dylan.
